



HORSE SET-UP

The property at 184 High Road in Kalispell has 4 stalls and has been used for 3 horses, one stall was used for chickens. The stalls attached to the barn are 24' X 12' that are indoor/outdoor. The inside portion of the stalls are 12' X 12' and can be completely closed during cold weather.

By using 12' pipe sections you can easily set up the outside stalls allowing quick take down for cleaning and grading. The horses can go out in either pasture during the day and then brought in for separate morning and evening feedings.

Hay was kept inside the barn allowing very convenient feeding/ supplementing from inside the barn. Each stall has can lighting and its own electrical outlet for plugging in heated buckets.

The round pen was also constructed with 12' pipe sections, creating a large round pen allowing a rider to train, lope/canter their horse.

Large water troughs were kept in the pastures. Electrical is installed next to the trough in the top pasture to easily plug in a water heater. The front pasture has electricity nearby but was mainly used for warmer months.



Lots of Riding in the area

- From the property you can ride along a dedicated bridle path that belongs to the property owners.
- You can also ride from the property to an overlook to view Flathead Lake.
- Foy's lake is a beautiful short ride, where you can swim your horses!
- There is a nice flat level space with sand footing that accommodates a small arena.
- Heron Park Equestrian Facility is a quick 5 minute drive to miles of horseback riding trails, a cross country course as well as seasonal horse shows.
